



TAMU Poultry Institute for Youth Summer 2009 Texas A&M University



U.S. Poultry and Egg Association in conjunction with the Texas A&M Poultry Science Department, the Poultry Science Club, and the Poultry Science Aggie Leadership Council are the sponsors for the 2009 TAMU Poultry Institute for Youth. The institute will be held on the Texas A&M campus. The dates are **Sunday, June 14 through Wednesday, June 17, 2009**. The purpose of this program is to give high school students with an interest in learning about the poultry industry a chance to gain first hand knowledge. They will have the opportunity to meet both Texas A&M staff and Texas poultry industry leaders. A portion of the institute will also include hands on work with birds and areas of leadership.

Eligibility:

- 1) Students who will be enrolled the Fall of 2009 as high school juniors or seniors, or college freshmen.
- 2) Have a definite interest in the poultry industry.
- 3) Are willing to speak to other individuals/groups about the poultry industry through public appearances.
- 4) Interested in devoting four days to meeting with individuals from Texas A&M University and the Texas poultry industry.

Cost:

A registration fee of \$50 will be required for each participant that is selected for the Institute. This fee is to be paid upon acceptance to the program and will go towards a commemorative camp t-shirt and evening activities. **Do not send with application.** All other expenses (lodging and meals), except transportation to and from College Station, will be covered by the sponsorship of the U.S. Poultry and Egg Association.

Applications:

Selection procedure:

Participants will be selected by members of the Texas A&M Poultry Institute staff. Alternates will also be selected. Eligible participants will be selected on the basis of their applications and resumes. Notification letters will be sent out no later than **Friday, May 22, 2009**.
